Highlight or circle any words you need/want to clarify. 3. Write the definition of each word. 4. Look up the word in Greek or Hebrew. Write the definition. 5. Read the verses surrounding the verse for context. 6. Read and write the verse in 2 different versions. 7. Summarize your findings.
