**P**

**Passage :** After reading the passage write out the verse that stood out the most to you.

**E**

**Engage:** Go back and read the passage again. Highlight important words or concepts. Look up definitions for specific words. Use the following questions to guide you: Who is the audience? Are there cause and effect relationships? Attributes of God? Promises of God?

**A**

**Art:** Draw out your verse. It doesn't have to be perfect.

**R**

**Reflect** on the passage of scripture that you read. What did you learn? What stood out to you about the passage? How could you apply what you've learned to your life.

**L**

**Listen:** Take a few minutes to sit quietly before the Lord. What is he saying to you through this verse? Write it down.

**S**

**Speak:** Take this time to pray to the Lord. Use the scripture in your prayer if possible.
