Day 22: Exo 26-30

Reflect on the role of priests and the sacrificial system described in these chapters. How does the concept of sacrifice relate to your understanding of Jesus' sacrifice for you, and what does it teach you about God's holiness?

In Exodus 28, the high priest's garments are described. How does the attire of the high priest convey the idea of approaching God with reverence? How can you bring reverence into your own prayers and worship?

Reflect on the institution of the Sabbath in Exodus 31. How do you currently set apart time for God in your life? How might observing a day of rest impact your relationship with Him?



Day 23: Exo 31-35

Exodus 31 highlights the skilled craftsmen chosen by God. Reflect on your own talents and skills. How can you use them to honor God and contribute to His purposes? Consider the voluntary contributions of the Israelites for the construction of the Tabernacle. How can you apply the principle of giving with a willing heart in your own life, whether it be time, talents, or resources?

Reflect on the radiant face of Moses described in Exodus 34. How might spending time with God, like Moses did on Mount Sinai, impact your own spiritual glow and witness to others?



Day 24: Exo 36-40

In Exodus 36, the skilled workers carry out the construction of the Tabernacle according to God's specifications. How can unity among believers lead to effective ministry and spiritual growth?

Exodus 40 narrates the erection of the Tabernacle and the descent of God's glory. How does this display of God's presence influence your desire for God's presence in your life today?

Consider the Israelites' obedience to the cloud's movements. How patient are you in waiting for God's timing and direction in your life?



Day 25: Lev 1-5

Leviticus 1-5 introduces various offerings for atonement. How does the concept of sacrifice for forgiveness of sins deepen your appreciation for Jesus' sacrifice on the cross?

Reflect on the burnt offering and the idea of total surrender to God. In what areas of your life do you need to surrender more fully to God's control?

Reflect on the guilt offering and the concept of restitution. Is there anyone you need to seek forgiveness from or reconcile with in your life?



Day 26: Lev 6-10

Reflect on the incident of Nadab and Abihu offering unauthorized fire. How can this cautionary tale inform your approach to worship and obedience to God's commands?

Leviticus 8-10 details the consecration of Aaron and his sons as priests. How can the concept of priestly holiness inspire your commitment to living a holy life?

Leviticus 10 introduces the importance of distinguishing between the clean and the unclean. How can you maintain spiritual discernment in your daily choices and associations?
