Day 71: 1 Samuel 15-19

Reflect on Saul's disobedience in 1 Samuel 15. How does Saul's disregard for God's commands contrast with Samuel's emphasis on obedience over sacrifice, and what can you learn from this for your own life?

Reflect on David's victory over Goliath in 1 Samuel 17. How does David's courage and reliance on God inspire you to face your own giants and challenges with faith?

Consider Saul's jealousy and pursuit of David in 1 Samuel 18-19. How does Saul's descent into paranoia and irrational behavior serve as a warning against the destructive nature of jealousy and insecurity?



Day 72: 1 Samuel 20-24

Reflect on Jonathan's covenant with David in 1 Samuel 20. How does Jonathan's loyalty and sacrificial love for David demonstrate the power of true friendship and brotherhood?

Consider David's refusal to harm Saul, even when given the opportunity in 1 Samuel 24. How does David's demonstration of mercy and forgiveness challenge you to respond graciously to those who wrong you?

Consider how God protects and provides for David during his time of exile in 1 Samuel 23-25. How does David's experience of God's faithfulness encourage you to trust in God's provision in your own times of trial?



Day 73: 1 Samuel 25-29

Reflect on Abigail's wisdom and peacemaking efforts in 1 Samuel 25. How does Abigail's example inspire you to seek reconciliation and promote peace in your relationships?

Consider Saul's desperation and decision to consult a medium in 1 Samuel 28. How does Saul's misguided attempt to seek guidance outside of God's will serve as a cautionary tale about the dangers of spiritual compromise?

Explore David's time among the Philistines in 1 Samuel 27-29. How does David's deception and double life during this period highlight the consequences of compromising one's integrity and trust in God?



Day 74: 1 Samuel 30 - 2 Samuel 3

Consider the tragic outcome of the battle of Gilboa and Saul's death in 1 Samuel 31. How does Saul's demise serve as a sobering reminder of the consequences of disobedience and rebellion against God?

Consider David's anointing as king of Judah in 2 Samuel 2. How does this event signify the beginning of God's fulfillment of His promise to establish David's throne, and what lessons can you draw from it regarding God's faithfulness?

Explore David's rise to power and his establishment as king over all of Israel in 2 Samuel 2-3. How does David's ascent to the throne reflect God's sovereign plan and purpose, and what insights can you gain from it for your own journey of faith?



Day 75: 2 Samuel 4-8

Reflect on David's response to the murder of Ish-bosheth in 2 Samuel 4. How does David's commitment to justice tempered with mercy exemplify the qualities of a godly leader?

Explore the significance of the capture of Jerusalem and its designation as the capital city of Israel in 2 Samuel 5. How does this event foreshadow Jerusalem's future as the spiritual center of God's kingdom?

Consider David's humility and gratitude before God following his victories in 2 Samuel 7-8. How does David's acknowledgment of God's blessings and his desire to honor Him serve as a model for your own posture of humility and worship?
