Day 134: Job 40- Psalms 2

Reflect on God's response to Job out of the whirlwind and His challenge to Job's understanding of His sovereignty in Job 40-41. How does God's revelation of His power and wisdom challenge you to trust in His goodness and sovereignty, even in the midst of life's trials?

Consider Job's acknowledgment of God's majesty and his repentance for questioning God's wisdom in Job 42. How does Job's humility and submission before God's greatness challenge you to cultivate a posture of reverence and awe in your own relationship with God?

Day 135: Psalms 3-7

Explore the psalmist's assurance of God's presence and guidance in Psalm 5. How does the psalmist's reliance on God's righteousness and steadfast love challenge you to seek His direction and wisdom in your daily life?

Consider the psalmist's praise of God's faithfulness and salvation in Psalm 7. How does the psalmist's declaration of God's protection and vindication challenge you to testify to His goodness and to trust in His unfailing love?

Day 136: Psalms 8-12

Consider the psalmist's assurance of God's protection and refuge in times of trouble in Psalm 9. How does the psalmist's declaration of trust in God's justice challenge you to rely on His strength and to find security in His presence?

Reflect on the psalmist's contrast between the righteous and the wicked in Psalm 11. How does the psalmist's affirmation of God's righteousness challenge you to pursue holiness and to stand firm in your faith, even in the face of adversity?



Consider the psalmist's assurance of God's preservation of the righteous and His judgment of the wicked in Psalm 12. How does the psalmist's confidence in God's faithfulness challenge you to speak truth and to trust in His promises, even when surrounded by deceit?

Day 137: Psalms 13-17

Reflect on the psalmist's cry for God's attention and his longing for deliverance from despair in Psalm 13. How does the psalmist's honesty in expressing his feelings of abandonment challenge you to bring your own struggles and doubts before God in prayer?

Consider the psalmist's affirmation of God's lovingkindness and His salvation in Psalm 13. How does the psalmist's declaration of trust in God's faithfulness challenge you to cling to His promises and to find hope in His unfailing love?
