Day 183 : Proverbs 23-27

Proverbs 24:1-2 warns against envying wicked people. How do the friends and companions you choose influence your spiritual growth? How can you seek out relationships that encourage you to live righteously?

Proverbs 25 offers wisdom on dealing with conflict and difficult situations. How can you use these principles to address conflicts in your own life, whether at work, in your family, or with friends?



Consider the emphasis on self-control and patience in Proverbs 25-26. How can you develop greater self-control in areas where you struggle, and how might this impact your overall spiritual growth?

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Day 184: Proverbs 28- Ecclesiastes 1

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Day 185: Ecclesiastes 2-6

Ecclesiastes 5:4-5 advises on making vows to God. How seriously do you take your commitments and promises, both to God and to others, and how can you ensure you honor them?

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Day 186: Ecclesiastes 7-11

Consider the call to live with purpose and intentionality in Ecclesiastes 11:9-10. How can you ensure that your daily actions align with your faith and the purpose God has for your life?

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Day 187: Ecclesiastes 12- Song of Songs 4

Ecclesiastes 12:1 urges you to remember your Creator in the days of your youth. How can you keep God at the center of your life and decisions, regardless of your age or circumstances?

Reflect on the themes of love and marriage in Song of Songs 1-2. How does this poetic expression of love deepen your understanding of God's design for romantic relationships?



Song of Songs 3-4 portrays the passionate love between the bride and groom. How can this portrayal of love inspire you to cultivate deep, loving relationships that reflect God's love?
