Day 295: Luke 17-20

In Luke 17:20-21, Jesus talks about the Kingdom of God being within us. How do you understand the presence of God's Kingdom in your life, and how does it influence your daily actions?

Jesus shares the parable of the persistent widow in Luke 18. How can this story encourage you to be more consistent and persistent in your own prayer life?

In Luke 19:41-44, Jesus weeps over Jerusalem. How does this passage reflect Jesus' heart for those who reject Him, and how can it inspire you to share His love with others?



Day 296: Luke 21-24

In Luke 21, Jesus speaks about the signs of the end times. How does this teaching impact your understanding of the future and your readiness to meet Christ In Luke 22, Jesus shares the Last Supper with His disciples. How can participating in communion help you remember and appreciate Jesus' sacrifice for you?

The disciples on the road to Emmaus didn't recognize Jesus until He broke bread with them. How can you become more aware of Jesus' presence in your everyday life, especially in unexpected ways?



Day 297: John 1-4

Dig

In John 1:14, we read that "the Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us." How does the idea of God becoming human in Jesus impact your understanding of His love and closeness to you?

In John 3, Jesus tells Nicodemus about the need to be "born again." What does it mean to you to be born again, and how has your life changed since coming to faith in Christ?

Reflect on how belief in Jesus led to action in the lives of those He encountered. How is your belief in Jesus motivating you to take action in your own life?

Day 298: John 5-8

In John 5, Jesus heals a man who had been an invalid for 38 years. How does this story encourage you to bring your own struggles and long-standing issues to Jesus for healing?

Jesus says in John 8:31-32 that the truth will set you free. How have you experienced freedom in Christ, and what areas of your life still need to be brought into His truth?

Throughout these chapters, Jesus faces opposition from religious leaders. How can Jesus' example help you to respond to criticism or opposition in your own faith journey?



Day 299: John 9-12

In John 9, Jesus heals a man born blind. How does this story illustrate the difference between physical sight and spiritual sight, and how can you seek to see more clearly through the eyes of faith?

In John 10, Jesus describes Himself as the Good Shepherd. How does knowing that Jesus is your Shepherd, who knows you and lays down His life for you, bring comfort and security to your life?

Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead in John 11. How does this miracle strengthen your belief in Jesus' power over death and give you hope for eternal life?
