Day 303: John 17-20

In John 20:24-29, Thomas doubts until he sees the risen Jesus. How do you handle moments of doubt in your faith, and what can help you trust in Jesus even when you can't see the full picture?

Day 305: Acts 4-7

The early believers in Acts shared everything in common and cared for one another (Acts 4:32-35). How can you practice generosity and community in your own life, especially toward fellow believers?

In Acts 6-7, Stephen becomes the first Christian martyr. What can you learn from Stephen's bold faith, and how can you be more courageous in sharing the gospel with others?



When Peter and the apostles are ordered to stop preaching in Acts 5:29, they respond that they must obey God rather than human authorities. How can you prioritize obedience to God in your life, even when it's difficult or unpopular?

Day 306: Acts 8-11
