Day 310: Acts 16-19

In Acts 16:9-10, Paul responds to a vision calling him to Macedonia. How can you discern and respond to God's call for you, whether in your personal life, work, or relationships?

Day 31: Acts 20-23

In Acts 20:24, Paul speaks about finishing the race and completing the task God has given him. What tasks or goals do you believe God has called you to, and how can you stay faithful to complete them?

Day 312: Acts 24-27

In Acts 27, Paul and his companions face a literal storm at sea, yet Paul remains calm and trusts God. How do you respond to the “storms” in your life, and how can you develop a deeper trust in God during those difficult times?

Throughout Acts 24-27, Paul’s life is at risk, but God protects him. How has God protected or guided you in ways you didn’t expect, and how does this increase your faith?
